

## Cleaning & Disinfection

Intensified cleaning and disinfection measures will ensure the physical spaces, equipment, and materials that our staff and students come into contact with remain safe. High-touched surfaces will be cleaned by staff multiple times throughout the day. Restrooms will be monitored and cleaned more frequently throughout the day.

In the cafeteria, all regulations and guidelines will continue to be followed in all processes of meal service. High-touched surfaces will be cleaned before meal service, during transitions, and after meal service.

Seating charts will be kept by all classroom teachers and bus drivers.

## Illness Procedures

CCSS will employ social distancing strategies to increase space between individuals and post signs to remind staff and students of 3-6-foot social distancing to the maximum extent possible.

If your child has any COVID-19 like symptoms described below, they will need to stay home.

- Fever of  $\geq 100.4^{\circ}$  F, cough, shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, runny nose, congestion, headache, sore throat, or loss of taste/smell

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 please contact the school nurse.

When to Return:

- If tested positive for COVID-19
  - Contact the school nurse
  - Quarantine for 5 days
  - May return to school after day 5 (if symptom free)
  - Mask for 5 additional days
- Exposure to an individual who tested positive for COVID-19
  - Vaccinated students do not have to quarantine, but must wear a mask for 10 days
  - Unvaccinated students must quarantine for 5 days and wear a mask for 5 additional days
- During contact tracing, if it is determined that the positive student and the exposed students were both wearing masks, the exposed student will not have to quarantine.
- No-cost COVID-19 testing is available through the Ochsner Health System.

## Quarantine Attendance

Quarantined students in grades 3-12, who have not tested positive, are required to log into the Google Meet link located within your Google Classroom to receive credit for attendance. Students will be provided with a link by teachers and must be visible and participate the entire class period while wearing a uniform shirt.

## Face Coverings

In the event of a mask mandate by the Governor, CCSS students in K-12th grade, staff, and visitors will be required to wear face coverings while indoors and on the bus. Choir and band activities can occur inside following recommendations from the NFHS and NAFME organizations. If unable to follow these recommended guidelines, activities should occur outside, as weather permits.

## Handwashing & Water Fountains

Handwashing or use of hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol will occur at arrival, at least every 2 hours, before and after eating (or sanitary wipe), and at the exit. Good hygiene practices will be encouraged and discussed in the classroom. Students are encouraged to bring a small hand sanitizer with them to school.

Water fountains will not be operational. Students will be encouraged to bring water bottles to school. CCSS has water bottle fillers at each school site.
